

>>> LOCKS

On the Rhine-Rhône Canal, most of the locks are automatic and easy to operate via a remote control.

THE REMOTE CONTROL:

- from your boat hire company
- from the Besançon office of VNF
- at one end of the canal to be handed back at the other: lock No.75 at St. Symphorien and lock No.8 at Allenjoie

WHEN PASSING THOUGH A LOCK.

- life jackets are compulsory for all persons on the deck
- children under 16 must remain inside the boat
- in addition to the compulsory lifejacket, anyone handling mooring lines should wear gloves to avoid rope burns
- the boat's engine must be running and in neutral (out of gear)
- never block a mooring line during the lock crossing: lines must be allowed to slide freely

Never park the boat in a lock.

>> HOW TO USE THE REMOTE CONTROL

If you are going upstream (against the current), press 1 and confirm with the OK button.

If you are going downstream (with the current), press 2 and confirm with the OK button.

An orange light will blink beneath the lock's traffic lights to confirm you have been detected.

Pressing "Stop" interrupts the gate movement and the valves. To restart the cycle, press OK.



>> SPECIAL PASSAGES

Thoraize tunnel Tarragnoz tunnel Lifejackets are compulsory when passing through tunnels and the boat's navigation

lights must be turned on.



Keep an electric hand lamp handy.

Rancenay double locks:

cross these just like a standard lock, follwing the same rules. Leave the first lock then enter the second.

Saint Paul manually operated lock at Besançon: the same requirements apply as for a standard lock.
